

Helpful Tips and Guidelines



ALL RECIPES ARE DUE NO LATER THEN SEPTEMBER 1, 2019

Preparation

- Select a dish that can be easily transferred from your kitchen to the Ella Sharp Rotunda.
- Test your recipe before the event, to make sure it will serve well in quantity
- Submit your name of the recipe and basic description (if needed) to Jessica as soon as possible.
- ♦ Start collecting donations from friends and family in support of AWARE. There will be a prize worth \$300 for the person that collects the most, and of course bragging rights too.

Day-of-Event Food Preparation and other Guidelines

- ♦ Deliver prepared items to the rotunda by 4:00 pm. Event starts promptly at 4:30 pm
- Donations you have raised will be collected at the beginning of the event before we start.
- Set up your space any way you like using a Halloween theme. The booth with the best presentation will win award worth \$300.
- ♦ This year there will not be electric so please plan accordingly. AWARE, Inc. will provide utensils and containers, but we do not provide crockpots, chafing dishes, etc.
- ♦ It is highly recommended (if you don't like to clean up) that you use disposable items such as the Sterno 70222 24-Piece Disposable Party Set available on Amazon or locally at Gordons Food Service. This comes with everything you'll need and all can be tossed at the end of the night.
- Each chef will have a table and two chairs set up in the rotunda. You will only be serving food to the carhops and judges who will bring the to-go container to you to add a portion of your entrée to. The carhops will then take the filled to go container to the cars for you.
- Volunteers and staff will be onsite to assist you with anything you may need but you must stay entire duration of the event to aid in serving.
- Deliver all side components with your prepared items (i.e., dipping sauces, spices,etc)
- Tasting will end at 6:30 pm, so please do not pack up early.
- ♦ You will be responsible for cleaning up your space before you leave at the end of the night which will conclude at 6:30pm
- ♦ At 6:30pm judges will announce the winners and chef prizes will be given out for best tasting, most creative booth and most donations raised.
